### **DR LEE REYNIS**

"State of the Economy:  
US, New Mexico,  
Albuquerque"

Dr. Lee A. Reynis is currently the Director of both the Institute for Applied Research Services and the Bureau of Business and Economic Research at the University of New Mexico. Dr. Reynis has been a close observer of the New Mexico economy for some 25 years and is actively involved in the production of BBER's quarterly economic forecasts using the FOR-UNM model. Dr. Reynis is actively involved in the research efforts of BBER, serving as principal investigator on a number of projects, including on-going analysis of Industrial Revenue Bond proposals for the City of Albuquerque and a recent analysis of the financial feasibility of a South Valley municipality.

Before joining the BBER staff as Associate Director in 1998, she was the City Economist for the City of Albuquerque. Prior to that she worked as an economic analyst and then as the Chief Economist for the New Mexico Department of Finance and Administration in Santa Fe. Dr. Reynis has taught a number of courses over the years at the University of New Mexico and was formerly on the faculty at the University of Utah. She holds an M.A. and a Ph.D. in economics from the University of Michigan.
